

Johnsburg Boys Baseball League ~ General Meeting Minutes

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer's report was approved by Jim Balfanz and seconded by Wendy Lemcke.

Minutes: The minutes were approved by Jim Balfanz and seconded by Greg Sobiesk.

Old Business: Jack Tinsley is still running for Vice-President, but Joe Kilbride dropped out of the election. Janice Ricci is no longer running as well. Bill Molidor stated that Wendy Lemcke could be a write in for secretary, or the board could appoint her to the position. Everyone agreed to Wendy as a write in.

Bill Molidor has all the player evaluations. Jim Balfanz has the equipment from all but 2 Pinto teams.

Information for 2010 registration will be mailed out in November. The scheduled dates for registration are Saturday, January 9, 2010 and Sunday, January 17, 2010. These dates need to be confirmed with Dick's Sporting Goods in McHenry as that is where registration will be. Bill Molidor will bring a rough draft for the parent take away to October's meeting.

Talks are still continuing regarding a new Nippersink league. Some of the teams are protesting the new league and there have been suggestions of having different divisions within the same league. Talks will continue and Bill Molidor will keep everyone updated.

New Business: Ringwood school is putting up a garage so JBBL will have to move the concession stand down.

Mike Koeshall and Bill Molidor continue talks with the village to have more games played at Hiller Park. This will make it easier to play make up games.

Jim Balfanz suggested that any person without a child shouldn't be on the executive board for JBBL. Jim is going to chair a committee to change these bi-laws.

We are still in need of many volunteers. We need to have 2 co-coordinators for the Jr. High concession stand by January. This way they can take the exam at the Health

Department and ensure they are certified by opening day. The coordinators will pay for their own license. Once they are certified, the JBBL will reimburse them for their expenses. Jeff Jayko is the mustang coordinator. Ken Elliott will be the coordinator of Bronco, if Eric Crow doesn't want the position. All the available positions will be posted on the website.

It was agreed upon by everyone in attendance that the elections would be done by a show of hands. There were no write-ins for Vice-President. Jack Tinsley won the position by a vote of 10 people. Wendy Lemcke was the only write-in for secretary. She won her position by a vote of 8 people. No one voted against Jack or Wendy. The president and treasurer's positions will be open for election in September of 2010.
