Concession Stand - Things were a bit of a mess from a scheduling stand-point so we look to make a big improvement, moving to cans away from bottles on pop, the concession stand is our single largest source of revenue so we need to maximize that, it will be critically important for us to notify the concession coordinator if any games are cancelled, we are going to be much stricter this year about depositing checks if people do not work their day,

Opening Day - Flag raising at 10:30AM, two balls per game and all the kids will sign them, selling food, Crowe family is taking lead on taking care of the bathrooms,

Equipment - We have new helmets and catchers gear so if needed we have replacements, contact Jim Balfanz, every team is going to be given two game balls per game, make sure you treat them as a controlled resource, be very careful pulling the groomer into the shed.

All Stars? - Half way through the season we'll figure out who wants to manage a team and go from there, the fees for the tournaments have gone up significantly so the league will only be able to cover up to \$300 and the rest will have to be covered by the parents, Eric brought up the concept of having an Bronco championship game on (pick 5 kids per team and they will make up the two teams).

Eric Crowe asked about cleaning supplies and Bill advised that everything was in the concession stand.
